Clarification of News Report

We refer to your letter dated December 7, 2016 with respect to the news article entitled "CebuPac to acquire planes for US flights" posted in Manila Standard (Internet Edition) on December 6, 2016. The article reported in part that:

"Cebu Air Inc., the operator of budget carrier Cebu Pacific, plans to acquire new-generation widebody aircraft for long-haul flights to the US West Coast, according to an aviation think tank.

The Centre for Asia-Pacific Aviation said Cebu Pacific was studying the acquisition of A350, 787 and A330 neo and planned to issue a formal tender to Airbus and Boeing in the third quarter of 2017.

This is to confirm that Cebu Air, Inc. (the "Company") has been evaluating new generation wide body aircraft that would enable it to enter new markets such as the United States. These evaluations are a part of the Company's routine long term planning process as it considers options for potential growth. No formal decisions have yet been made to enter such markets.
