Clarification of News Report

We refer to your letter dated April 30, 2019 with respect to the news article entitled "Cancellations hound Cebu Pacific" posted in The Manila Times (Online Edition) on April 30, 2019. The article reported in part that:

"“LOW-COST carrier Cebu Pacific remains unsure if operations would return to normal next month after canceling flights due to what it had described as an ‘unprecedented level of disruption.’

‘We are still assessing May operations,’ Cebu Pacific spokesman Charo Logarta-Lagamon said in a mobile message when asked if such cancellations would extend for a few more days.

This comes after the Gokongwei-led airline announced on Sunday the cancellation of several flights from Sunday to Tuesday.

This move was necessary ‘to create more space in our schedule for operational recovery and minimize rolling delays,’ Cebu Pacific said.

‘These flight cancellations should help stabilize flight timings, improve on time performance and reduce inconvenience to our passengers,’ it added.

Over the past few days, Cebu Air, Inc. ("CEB") has seen an unprecedented level of disruption to its operations, and its passengers are experiencing extended delays and some on-the-spot cancellations. To create space in its schedule for operational recovery, minimize rolling delays and give passengers the chance to make alternate travel plans, CEB has to temporarily reduce the number of its flights given the current operating conditions, particularly in its Manila hub. For the month of May, CEB will be reducing approximately 10 flights a day out of a daily operations of 400 flights. CEB is currently reviewing adjustments required for June and beyond.

The priority of CEB is to assist disrupted passengers and fly them to their destinations at the soonest possible time. CEB is working with the airport authorities, regulatory agencies and other stakeholders to make things better for our passengers.

The flight cancellations will not have a significant effect on the business operations and financial condition of CEB.
